



WINDOW-LEVEL TOOL

Query

A full SQL editor — write, execute, and review results from any SQL statement or batch, with a syntax-highlighted editor.

Who

WHO IT IS FOR

Users comfortable with SQL who want a fast editor for ad-hoc statements, scripts, and stored-procedure work.

What

WHAT IT DOES

The Query window pairs a list of database objects (functions, procedures, triggers) with a syntax-highlighted SQL editor. Browse to an object to see its source, or write and execute your own SQL and review the results.

When

WHEN TO USE IT

Use it for ad-hoc exploration, debugging stored procedures, testing schema changes, or running one-off administrative scripts.

Where

WHERE TO FIND IT

Open it from the Query button in the Searcher header (a Pro feature). The object list is on the left, the SQL editor on the right.

Why

WHY IT MATTERS

Sometimes the fastest path is to type the SQL. The Query window gives you a proper editor and object browser without leaving McSaver Search.
